

## Rental Availability

Once summer camp has concluded, Camp Cherokee is available for group rental. Beginning in late August and running through the end of May, Camp Cherokee can be your destination. We offer weekend, full week and 10 day rentals at a price that cannot be beat!



## Areas

Camp Cherokee features 3 areas of cabins.

Paradise Valley (PV) offers 9 cabins including 2 cabins constructed in 2009 that house 16 campers. PV can be home to 80.

Barbary Coast (BC) and Chigger Junction (CJ) both offer 8 cabins and can sleep a total of 60.

All 3 areas have a latrine with 3 toilets and a large basin sink. The shower facility is located near PV and is just a short walk from all areas of camp.

## Cabins

Our rustic cabins were constructed in the 1930's as a part of the Civilian Conservation Corps.

18 Cabins - 4 bunks (sleeps 8)

5 Cabins - 2-3 bunks (sleeps 4-6)

2 cabins - 8 bunks (sleeps 16) \*Built in 2009

## Mess Hall

The highlight of the facilities at Camp Cherokee is the Mess Hall. This dining facility features seating for 200 and a wonderful rustic feel. State and Country flags line the ceilings representing all of the places our campers have hailed from. The full service kitchen has 2 walk-in coolers, 2 freezers, a commercial ice maker, 12 eye stove top and 2 ovens.

## Programs

**Rock Climbing:** Let our trained staff facilitate your group on our 35 ft. climbing wall. This 2 sided towers features 4 unique runs and a 200 foot zip line.

**Watercraft:** Take a trip out on the water on one of our canoes or sailboats. Life jackets and other equipment included.

-  Camp Cherokee was originally constructed as a part of the Civilian Conservation Corps in the 1930's.
-  The Upper Palmetto YMCA's resident camp has operated since 1946 and serves close to 800 youth each summer.
-  Camp Cherokee is available for rental groups from late August - mid May (the camp is closed for winter and not available from December 1st - March 1st).
-  Camp Cherokee features 25 cabins and can accommodate groups up to 200 people.
-  Camp Cherokee sits on Lake York, King Mountain State Park 66 acre pristine lake.
-  From Boy/Girl Scout Troops, to church retreats, to family reunions, Camp Cherokee is a great place for your group to have an exciting weekend,
-  We are just 30 minutes from Charlotte and 1 hour from Greenville only 5 minutes from I-85.
